

## ● High level summary GFF (day 2)

- Community of common purpose – towards Mission driven research
- Numerous examples of increased emphasis on Mission Initiatives
- Partnerships, multilateral cooperation key, equitable partnerships
- What does it take? – systems perspectives, tiered/ nested approach (at least regional and global)
- Co-design rate limiting components that inhibit transformations to sustainable futures/societies
- Collectively defined missions driven – deliver sustainability outcomes (no proposal driven/ no funder)
- Socio-political challenge (selected research contributions)
- Transdisciplinary framework: interdisciplinary, intersectoral, international (Policy advice - impact)
- Leverage/ harness existing science networks to enhance mission centres
- Common funding pool (fiscal agent approach?) – funding beyond your pond!!
- Not for everyone – coalition of the willing – need to agree there is a problem
- Capacity enhancement in global south using the Missions platform(s) – associate fellowships
