The voting process

Statute 15 (ii): Regarding voting on elections and other procedural matters

- Each Member of **Category 1** will have a **weighted vote** equal to the total number of country, territory or region votes divided by the total number of Members of Category 1, within the total membership base.
- Each Member of **Category 2** shall have **one vote**, except in cases where there is more than one Member of Category 2 representing the same country, territory or region as defined by the General Assembly, in which case the Members from that country, territory or region need to agree on a common voting position resulting in a single vote. Should there be no agreement amongst them, each Member of Category 2 shall have a proportion of that one vote.
