





The ISC works with its Members, partners and sponsored initiatives on a set of targeted, priority projects, which are set out in regular multi-year Action Plans.


The 2022-2024 Action Plan sets out an agenda for transformative action across five domains of impact:

# A FRAMEWORK FOR EVALUATING RAPIDLY DEVELOPING DIGITAL AND RELATED TECHNOLOGIES


AI, large language models and beyond
