TRANSFORMATION:

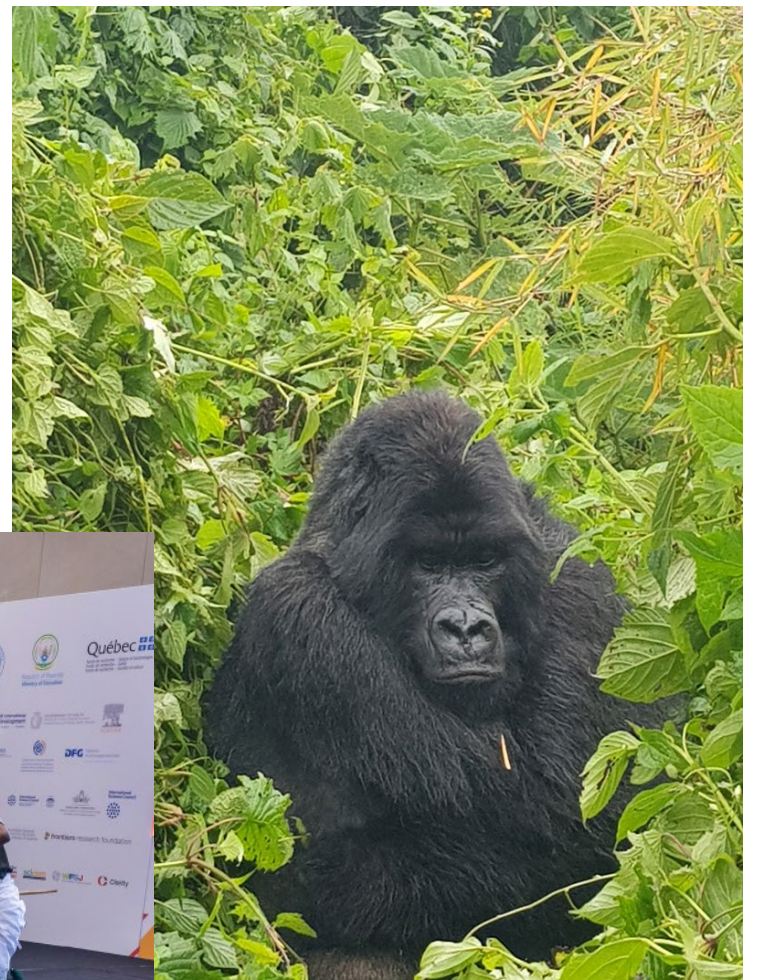
- How knowledge is generate, transmitted, and used matters from the local to the multilateral.
